Abstract submission guidelines

- Abstracts must be written in English
- Maximum 300 words (excluding title and author details)
- Structured format:
 - Background
 - Aims / Objectives
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Conclusion
 - References
- Include 3–6 keywords
- Submission details/link will be communicated separately

Review and Presentation

- All abstracts will undergo peer review by the Scientific Review Committee.
- Accepted abstracts will be allocated to:
 - Oral presentations, or
 - Poster presentations, based on scientific merit and thematic fit.
